### Ecole Father Laz

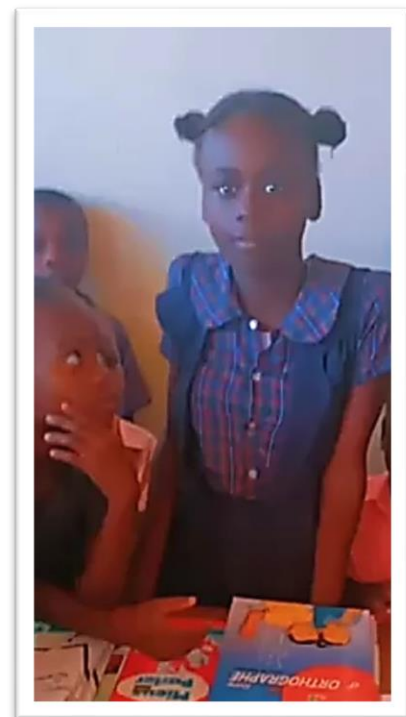
- Purchased and delivered teaching and learning materials

“Thank you Food For The Poor for all those books, because our parents couldn't afford to buy them for us,” she said. “On behalf of all the students, I say thank you again.”

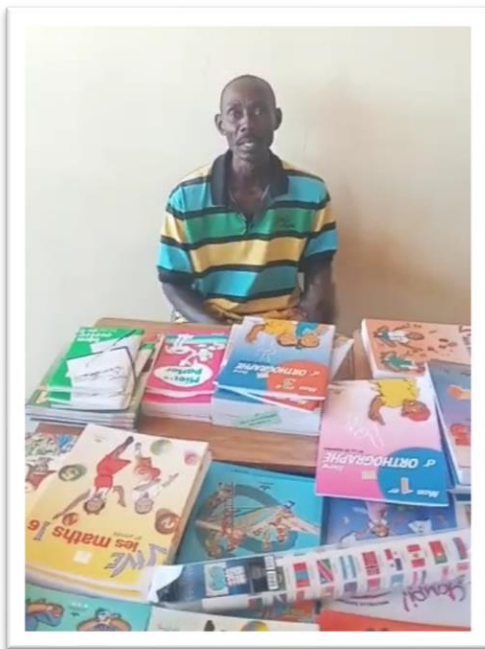
With these new learning materials, Pierreline and her peers have the opportunity to sharpen their skills and obtain a well-rounded education.
